1

Get your bearings

- This playbook = your pocket companion for reflections + connections.
- The mobile app = your real-time hub for schedule, updates, and networking.

Download the Summit app (do this early!)

- Download **Eventscribe** (container app).
- Open it and search for **ICF Converge Summit 2026**.

3

Log in

Use the **same email + password you used to register** (your ICF website login).

4

Build your agenda

Star/save sessions you want — then your schedule is ready when you are.

5

Set yourself up for connection

Pick ONE:

- Schedule your first **Braindate**.
- Join a **Keynote Reflection Break**.
- Sit with someone new at your next break.

Pro tip: Wi-Fi can be unpredictable at venues.
Download the app before you arrive.

The Summit Difference: Connection Playbook



Connection is the point.

Converge Summit is designed so you don't just leave with notes — you leave with new perspectives, real relationships, and ideas you can use immediately.

1) Braindates (your “meet your people” tool)

Braindates are 1:1 or small-group conversations you schedule in the app — to exchange ideas, workshop challenges, and spark collaborations.

Try these Braindate prompts:

- “I’m refining my niche — want to compare notes?”
- “What’s one client challenge you’re seeing everywhere right now?”
- “How are you building community in your coaching work?”
- “AI, ethics, and coaching ... what are you excited (or nervous) about?”

2) Keynote Reflection Breaks (turn inspiration into action)

After each keynote, join a small facilitated group to reflect and connect what you heard to your work. “Personal playgrounds for ideas.”

3) The easiest networking move (no awkwardness required)

Ask one question:

“What’s one thing you’re hoping to take home from this Summit?”

How To Use This Playbook

This playbook is your Summit sidekick.

Use it to:

- Capture **aha moments** you don't want to forget.
- Track **people you want to stay connected with** (future collaborators included).
- Turn insights into action with a few quick prompts — before you fly home.

When to pull it out:

- Right after a session.
- During a Braindate.
- After a Keynote Reflection Break.
- Anytime you think: "Ooh... I need to remember that."

CCE in 60 Seconds

Paris between sessions

You're on the **Left Bank** — a great area for quick walks, cafés, and little Paris moments.

Quick coffee / bite ideas (near the hotel)

- La Vie D'Ange (3 min walk).
- Marso (8 min walk).
- Pavillion Montsouris (15 min walk).
- Auberge Etchegorry (14 min walk).

If you have 60–90 minutes...

- Parc Montsouris (10 min walk).
- Les Catacombes de Paris (12 min walk).
- Butte-aux-Cailles (15 min walk).

Bonus: The best networking sometimes happens outside the schedule — invite someone to a quick coffee walk.
